**Admission to Show:** Free

**Refunds:** None

**Returned Check Policy:** If a check is returned unpaid, the show will assess a \$25.00 fee and a money order, cashiers check or cash must be presented to show management. No premiums will be paid until all delinquent funds are collected.

9:00 am-6:00 pm - Friday, May 22

**Show Check-in Requirements:** All ponies and cobs will be accompanied with a record of a negative official test for EIA (Coggins) conducted within the past 12 months. You must present the original form and not a copy upon arrival. Foals less than 6 months of age, accompanied by and nursing a negative tested mare are exempt from the testing requirements. This is a state law and show management will check papers when you arrive and if proper documentation is not present, you will not be permitted to remain on the grounds.

**Measurements:** All Welsh which do not possess a valid measurement card will be measured as required by the official measurer. Measurement will be Friday, May 22 12:00 to 4:00 pm. It is the owner's responsibility to make a measurement time. Animals five (5) and under shown only in halter are not subject to measurement.

**Stalls and Bedding:** Arrangements for access to stalls prior to 8:00 am Friday must make arrangements with Denise Dougherty (cell phone: 580-402-6558) to get into the stalls. Participants arriving before Friday and/or leaving after Monday will be charged an additional \$15.00 per day per stall. Bedding may be brought in or purchased at the fairgrounds.

Prize monies will be mailed within 60 days following the show.

**Sanctioning:** This is a Provisional Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America (WPCSA) Double Gold Show. Show #1 is designated the Central National. All WPCSA classes will conform to the class specifications, which are included herein. Welsh performance championships are based on points only, no entry fees are required for those classes. To qualify for entry in Stake classes, the exhibitor must enter and compete in at least one other class in the division.

## **2 Rules & Regulations**

---

**Classes:** Show management reserves the right, with permission of the exhibitors, to cancel classes that have no entries, or to divide the classes in which the entries cannot be accommodated in the ring at one time, and to make such changes in the class schedule as dictated by the interest of the show. If there are 8 or more 12.2 and under and 8 or more over 12.2 to 14.2 hand ponies in any WPCSA class, it will be split. Classes are open to stallions, mares and geldings. WPCSA classes of less than three entries will receive reduced points and will not be combined.

**Breed Specifications:** *Section A Welsh Pony* - Not exceeding 12.2 hands  
*Section B Welsh Pony* - Not exceeding 14.2 hands  
*Section C Welsh Pony of Cob Type* - 13.2 hands & under  
*Section D Welsh Cob* - Over 13.2 hands  
*Small Pony* - 12.2 hands and under  
*Medium/Large Pony* - Over 12.2 hands, not exceeding 14.2 hands

**Attire:** Riders must be properly attired according to the rules of the division in which they are competing. Riders in all classes where jumping is required, and when jumping elsewhere on the show grounds, must wear protective headgear. Numbers must be worn and be clearly visible.

**Adult Exhibitors:** An individual who has reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year.

**Junior Exhibitors:** An individual who has not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. When dividing junior divisions into two separate age groups, they will be split as follows: youth 12 & under and youth 13 and over (but have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st of the current competition year. Juniors under 14 years of age cannot show a stallion. Junior Drivers under 14 years of age must have an experienced adult (over 18) in the carriage at all times. **Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.**

**Headquarters Motels:** Blocks of rooms have been set aside at both the Best Western and Econo Lodge. (See ad on page 7 for more information.) There are a limited number of rooms at the discounted rate, so call as soon as possible. Ask for Welsh Pony Rate. Reservations must be made by May 1 to receive show rate.

**Facilities:** F150 Barn and Pavilion at Expo Square Tulsa State Fair Grounds, 15th and Yale Avenue. Enter through gate 6 or 7 on 15th street. This is an indoor facility.

**R.V. Hook-ups:** R.V. Hook-ups are available on a first come, first served basis, on the Expo Square grounds, just north of the arena. Hook-up is subject to Expo Square Management 918-744-1113.

**Parking:** Parking in front and side of the barns is restricted due to fire safety regulations and to allow exhibitors to pass from the stabling area to the show arena safely. Vehicles parked in restricted areas are subject to towing. **Please keep all valuables out of sight and in your trunk or on your person to deter theft.**

**Dog Policy:** All dogs must be kept on a leash or confined in a secure enclosure.

# Class Specifications 3

## **WPCSA BREED CLASSES** (Article 110.2)

Animals are to be shown in hand at a walk and a trot except in group classes. Purebred Welsh to be judged 85% on breed type, conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on disposition and manners. Natural reaching action is desired. Half-Welsh to be judged 85% on conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on Welsh breed type, disposition and manners.

## **WPCSA SHOWMANSHIP** (Article 115.6)

Classes should be offered for exhibitors 12 & under and 13-17 years of age. Judged on presentation and showman's ability to show his/her pony/cob/half Welsh. 40% of the judging is on neatness and appearance of the showman, pony and tack. 60% will be based on the exhibitor's ability to present his/her pony/cob/half Welsh. Exhibitors will be informed of the judge's choice of pattern to be used, before entering the ring.

## **WPCSA LEADLINE WALK** (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk-trot, and leadline walk-trot poles.

### **69. WPCSA Leadline Walk, Child 7 and under**

## **WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT** (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk and trot. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk, and leadline walk-trot poles.

### **70. WPCSA Leadline Walk-Trot, Child 7 and under**

## **WPCSA LEADING REIN** (Article 115.1)

Section A or B, C or Half-Welsh, mare or gelding, 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than eight, years of age. Riders to be suitably dressed in Hunt, Saddle or Western attire including protective headgear. To be shown at a walk, on the right rein (clockwise), to line up and stand quietly. Ponies will be called out individually to stand, walk out and trot or jog back past the judge. Ponies to be judged on manners, suitability, breed type, conformation and turnout. This is not an equitation class.

### **71. WPCSA Leading Rein, Child 4-8**

## **WPCSA CHILD'S FIRST PONY** (Article 115.2)

Section A, B, C and Half-Welsh, mare or gelding 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than 10, years of age. Ponies to be shown at a walk and trot or jog, both ways of the ring. Ponies to be judged on performance, manners and suitability. Conformation, way of going, and turnout to be emphasized. This is not an equitation class.

### **72. WPCSA Child's First Pony, 12.2 & under, Child 4-10**

## **WPCSA WALK** (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot, walk-trot poles. To walk both ways of the ring.

### **73. WPCSA Walk, Child 11 and under**

## **WPCSA WALK-TROT** (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk, walk-trot poles.

### **74. WPCSA Walk-Trot, Child 11 and under**

## **WPCSA WALK-TROT POLES** (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around over a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of four feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk, or walk-trot.

## OPEN PET PONY OBSTACLE

Safety is a primary concern and suitability of child to pony will be emphasized. Child will lead pony over and around obstacles demonstrating their ability to control and maneuver the pony in a safe manner. Attire is not to be considered in judging unless considered unsafe. Adults or older juniors may accompany child and pony in the ring.

## WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC SEC. C & D (Article 115.7)

This class is for registered Welsh Cobs and Welsh Ponies of Cob Type 4 years of age and over. To be judged 50% on performance and 50% on conformation. To be shown at the walk, trot, canter displaying Welsh movement as described in the breed description. An individual performance showing all gaits in both directions by each participant will be required (the gallop need only be shown in one direction). Each animal will then be stripped for conformation judging. Once an entry has been judged for conformation, it can be retacked. UK Judge or qualified American Judge to officiate.

### **78. WPCSA Ridden Welsh Classic, Sec. C/D, Junior/Adult**

## WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC SEC. A & B (Article 115.8)

This class is for registered Welsh Ponies Section A & B 4 years of age and over. To be judged 50% on performance and 50% on conformation. To be shown at the walk, trot, canter displaying Welsh movement as described in the breed description. An individual performance showing all gaits in both directions by each participant will be required (the gallop need only be shown in one direction). Each animal will then be stripped for conformation judging. Once an entry has been judged for conformation, it can be retacked. UK Judge or qualified American Judge to officiate.

### **79. WPCSA Ridden Welsh Classic, Sec. A/B, Junior/Adult**

## WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC CHAMPIONSHIP (Article 115.9)

This class is for the 1st and 2nd place winners from the Welsh Classic classes for C&D and A&B. Full Details will be available after February 23, 2009.

## OPEN WORKING GREEN PLEASURE

Open to mares and geldings 2 and 3 years old. May be shown in English or Western tack. Snaffle bits, bosals, and martingales are permitted. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter/lope both ways of the ring. To be judged 100% on performance.

### **93. Working Green Pleasure (Snaffle Bit) English or Western, 2 & 3 yr. old, Walk-Trot, Open**

## WPCSA WELSH ENGLISH PLEASURE (Article 112.3)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without martingale. To be judged 75% on performance, manners movement and style: 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes to be judged 100% on performance.

Classes are open to ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Riders to be judged on seat, hands, performance of animal, appointments of animal and rider and suitability of animal to rider. Riders enter the ring at a walk or jog and are judged at a flat-footed four beat walk, two-beat jog and a three-beat lope both ways of the ring. All competitors are required to back a straight line during the line up. Tests may be required.

Classes open to ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Over Fence classes to be shown over a minimum of six obstacles. To be judged on the rider's appearance, seat, hands and control of their mount. Under saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Tests may be required.

To be judged 100% on performance. To be eligible for the under-saddle class, pony must be entered and complete a course in at least one over-fence class. Under-saddle class animals shown both ways of ring at a walk, trot and canter.

Riders in this division may not compete over fences in any other division except Short Stirrup Hunter. Animals must walk, trot and canter. Over Fences (o/f): Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of four fences with eight jumping efforts required. Animals may either trot or canter the entire course. The o/f class must precede the u/s class.

## **WPCSA CARRIAGE DRIVING** (Article 113.2)

Wire wheeled vehicles may be used at this show. Open to ponies, cobs and half Welsh. In addition to the gaits detailed in the pleasure driving section Article 113.1 (walk, working trot, trot-on, halt and rein-back), carriage driving also requires the slow trot which is slower and more collected but not to the degree required in the dressage collected trot. The animal should indicate a willingness to be driven on the bit while maintaining a steady cadence. Turnout to be judged 70% on the condition, fit and appropriateness of harness and vehicle, neatness and appropriateness of attire; and overall impression, 30% on performance, manners and way of going. Working class to be judged 70% on performance, manners and way of going; 20% on condition and fit of harness and vehicle; 10% on neatness of attire. Obstacle/Cones to be Judged 100% on performance.

## **WPCSA Obstacle - Time Competition**

Timed Competition. Not to exceed 20 obstacles (pairs of cones topped with tennis balls) To be driven over prescribed course of obstacles. 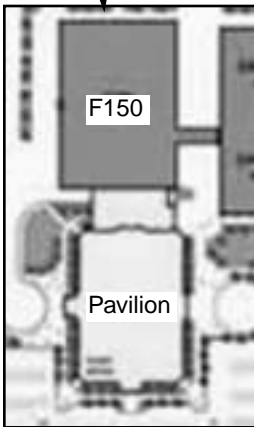
